

Vinnitsa region

Ancient people called this part of Ukraine a paradise on Earth. Our ancestors named the largest river that crosses Vinnitsa region (Southern Bug) the God.

The Most High has generously presented the most fertile lands in Europe and clear water rivers, thick forests and velvet meadows, plain steppes and severe heights to Vinnitsa region. This place united all attractive and generous things of Ukraine.

Vinnitsa is a region of powerful agriculture and multi-industrial complex. It is the largest sugar manufacturing center of Ukraine.

Vinnitsa region occupies the region of 26.5 ths. sq. km. Its population constitutes 1,720 mn people. Vinnitsa is located in 260 km from Kiev, the capital city of Ukraine.

Vinnitsa is extremely wealthy land, as all Ukraine in the whole. Foremost, the region boasts with rich mineral and raw stock base. There are 1,159 deposits of mineral resources in its entrails, including unique deposits of granite, fluorite, and the only European deposit of garnet, which can be applied in wood-processing industry and metallurgy. The region boasts the largest world deposit of competitive mineral raw stock kaolin. Range of its utilization is very broad: paper industry, ceramics (china and delftware), electric technical industry (insulators), refractories, aluminum, textile, cable, resin, chemical, soap boiling industries, as well as perfumery industry.

Besides, Vinnitsa region is the only place in Ukraine with great reserves of pelicanite, that can be used for getting of haydite, as a mineral additive to cement, and during manufacturing of ceramic tiles. Curative springs of mineral water, in particular with high content of radon in Khmelnik town, were developed and operate in Vinnitsa region. Vinnitsa region can soon occupy leading positions on export of mineral resources to the world market with such inestimable reserves of them.

Industrial potential of the region is presented by well-known trademarks of the following companies: Nemiroff, Agrana-Fruit Ukraine LLC, Ladyzhinskaya thermoelectric power station, OJSC Volodarka, OJSC Vinnitsa oil and fat integrated works, OJSC Mogilev-Podolskiy machine building plant, OJSC Vinnitsa plant of tractor units, State company Vinnitsa plant Crystal, Scientific production association Fort, Pfanner Bar LLC, OJSC Vinnifruit, and a lot of others.

Ukrainian black earths represent unique investment potential of Vinnitsa region. Lands of black earth type occupy approximately 21% of the region territory. It is a unique concentration of high quality land resources in the world scale.

Reforming of agroindustrial based on private property has been completed in the region. It provides great opportunities for fruitful cooperation of farmers with investors.

Land tenants of the region possess almost 2 mn ha of agricultural lands making 4.4% of the total Ukraine area. Growing of grain crops and sugar beet in plant growing and production of milk and meat in cattle breeding are peculiarities of regional agricultural farms.

A number of strategic highways crosses the territory of the region, including Uman-Krakovets. Extensive network of railway roads connect all main industrial centers of the region with Ukrainian, CIS, and European cities. Transportation corridors Lisbon-Naples-Budapest-Kiev and Warsaw-Odessa "Baltic Sea-Black Sea" will soon cross the territory of the region.

Three gas mainlines Urengoy-Pomary-Uzhgorod, Soyuz (Union), and Dashava-Kiev, as well as oil mainline Odessa-Brody cross the territory of the region.

Vinnitsa is a powerful scientific and cultural center of Podolye.

National technical and medical university, state pedagogical and agrarian universities, a number of economic higher educational establishments, research and development institutes, hundreds of cultural and educational establishments, regional academic music and drama and puppet theaters, philharmonic society, and sport constructions operate in the region.

Vinnitsa region is a birthplace of Mikhail Kotsubinskiy, Vasiliy Stus, Stepan Rudanskiy, and a lot of other famous cultural workers of Ukraine.

World famous estate museum of Nikolay Pirogov is situated in the outskirts of Vinnitsa. The region hosts numerous monuments of history and culture of Ukraine, as well as a lot of palaces, Roman-Catholic churches, churches, and synagogues. The largest in Ukraine Scythian site of ancient settlement and enchanted Ivanovski castle, and even mausoleum in Pechera are situated here.

Development of agricultural sector industries, fuel and energy complex, energy saving, development of production on the basis of mineral and raw stock utilization, agricultural machine building, as well as securing of complex settlement of environmental protection problems along with development of social sphere in villages are priorities of Vinnitsa region development.
